

# Oregon Open Legislature Initiative

## Prospective Initiative Petition

Amends Constitution:

“Beginning no later than January 1, 2015 all sessions of the Legislative Assembly shall be held in such a manner that all voting members of the Legislative Assembly shall vote on Legislative Issues only while physically located at a publicly accessible place within the geographic district which they represent.”

This petition document must be stapled to the signature sheets at all times.

This is a prospective petition for an Oregon Constitutional amendment. This is the first step to getting the amendment on the November 2010 ballot, and after we have collected 1,000 valid signatures of Oregon registered voters on these prospective petitions then we can apply for an approved ballot title and circulation authority for the general election
